Application Requirements and Qualifications **Be sure to check below

Please make sure to meet the following criteria and familiarize yourself with all the program requirements.

- ☑ While studying abroad at Hakuoh University, you will be enrolled as a student at your home institution.
- ☑ You are in good health and do not have any physical conditions that could prevent you from studying abroad.
- ☑ You have proved yourself to be a responsible student by completing and passing course requirements at your home university.
- ☑ You have completed at least two years (or four semesters) of classes at your home institution.
- ☑ You have completed at least two years (or four semesters) of Japanese language classes and have a basic understanding of conversational Japanese that would aid you in the host country.
- ☑ You have a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a four-point grading scale.
- ☑You have the motivation to actively participate in international exchange activities and want to be an active member of the Hakuoh University international exchange community.

Tuition

Students enrolled at Hakuoh University partner institutions are exempt from paying tuition for Hakuoh classes.

Housing rent: Free

The dormitory's rent of 30,000 yen is exempted as per the Agreement of Exchange between partner institutions. The student is required to be an active member of the university's international community. We ask that all exchange students at Hakuoh University allow time for the extra-curricular activities listed below:







•International Exchange Hour (Once a week):

- 3. Hakuoh University will send two documents to your home institution: Certificate of Eligibility and Letter of Acceptance.

 If necessary, you may receive additional admission documents from the Japanese Bureau of Immigration to complete. The Japanese Ministry of Law will conduct a background check to see if you are eligible for a visa to study abroad. Hakuoh University bears no responsibility if you are unable to obtain the necessary visa to study abroad.
- 4. Once your Certificate of Eligibility and Letter of Acceptance arrive, please submit these documents to your closest Japanese Consulate or Embassy. From there, your visa will be prepared.

Classes

Registration information will be provided at the class orientation (Zoom) prior to study abroad.

Notes on Course Registration

If you wish to participate in any course for full time students enrolled at Hakuoh University, please be aware of the following:

- •Classes will be conducted in Japanese, and an N2 level of Japanese comprehension will be necessary.
- •Registration for these classes will require the permission from the Hakuoh faculty or staff member.
- If a credited course is full and requires a lottery system to enter, you will not be able to register for the course.
- Whether or not course taken at Hakuoh will be eligible for credit at your home institution is up for your home university to decide. Please consult with your home institution before registering for a credited course at Hakuoh University.

Housing

Exchange students are permitted to stay at Hakuoh University dormitories for FREE room use except they will be required to pay for cleaning at the end of the stay, utility bills, Wi-Fi and SIM. After your arrival at Hakuoh University, a Room Cleaning Fee of 10,000 yen and Futon Fee 7,000 yen will be charged to each student.

Facilities: Studio apartment: Kitchen, bath/shower, shared washing machines, bed, and refrigerator.

*Wi-Fi: No contract is required for women's dormitory, but **men's dormitory requires a separate contract**. If you wish to sign up for a WiFi contract, we sincerely apologize, but please make the arrangements yourself.

Students are required to pay for all their utility bills.

**Utilities such as electricity, gas, and water need to be paid by either using a credit card or some form of online payment. Please be sure to have a credit card or alternative online payment method that can be used in Japan. For further details, please review below:

*Approximate expenses amount to 10,000 Yen per month. As per your visa status of College Student, in principle, you are not allowed to participate in part-time work. Please prepare any and all necessary funds for studying abroad before studying abroad or work out a remittance system with your expense supporter before departing for Japan.
